

A forecast is included for fixed,mobile and converged WiMAX, for fixed broadband, and for 3G subscribers, service revenue, device shipments, device shipments value, and Capex. A supplemental spreadsheet is included that includes the charts in the report along with additional charts and tables that provide further perspectives on the market.
